THE LAST SUPPER

I was asked up the church to write a piece to put in the village magazine as to how the wall hanging of The Last Supper arrived there.

“In 1991 my daughter left her home here in Sculthorpe to enter the William Booth training college in London to fulfil her calling to become a Salvation Army Officer (Minister of Religion).

She was commissioned in 1993. Her first appointment was in Belfast, at a Lifehouse for homeless families, followed by several years in Liverpool as the manager of the Salvation Army's homeless life house for single women.

Whilst clearing out one day there she came across the wall hanging of The Last Supper. Owing to the size of this piece of artwork brought it home and presented it our church, where she had gone many times when a pupil at the village school, to be displayed.

Since then, she has had appointments in Norwich as Children's Ministries Officer for East Anglia, Wellingborough as a Corps Officer, and is at present in charge of the Corps in Boston, Lincolnshire.” - **Ruth Woodhouse**
